

Church Floor Collapse Information Meeting

A proposed class action lawsuit relating to the floor collapse in the Central Heights Church on April 25, 2008, was filed by Webster & Associates against the B.C. Conference of the Mennonite Brethren Churches, and Unite Productions Inc. on May 8, 2008. A free information meeting will be held on June 26, 2008, between the hours of 7:00 and 10:00 at the Super 8 Abbotsford 1881 Sumas Way Abbotsford, BC.

Lawyers from Webster & Associates will be in attendance to provide general information about the proposed class action as well as to personally speak with and answer questions of those who may have been impacted by the incident.

The proposed Class Action filed by Webster & Associates, of Richmond, B.C. seeks to obtain compensation for all of those persons who suffered injuries, including physical and/or emotional injuries, as a result of the church floor collapse. It also seeks to obtain reimbursement for those who lost or had property damaged as a result of the collapse. It is not required that a person actually fell through the floor to have suffered injuries or damages in the tragic incident.

Class Action legislation has existed in BC since 1995, but class proceedings are not filed every day. Class actions are an effective method of dealing with injuries suffered by many people arising out of the same event.
